DESCRIPTION

Brief Description of the Constitutional Court The material for the Al-Islam and Kemuhmadiyah III lectures is designed to introduce students to the Muhammadiyah movement from its various contents. To provide an overview of the importance of this movement, the material begins with the Islamization of the archipelago and then is assembled into the origins and meaning of Muhammadiyah's presence, the articles of association and by-laws, the beliefs and ideals of life of Muhammadiyah, the personality of Muhammadiyah, and the Khittah of Muhammadiyah. To provide an overview of the Muhammadiyah movement, materials were presented ranging from Muhammadiyah as a Tajdid movement, as a religious movement, an educational movement, a social movement, a cultural movement, as well as values that are upheld and become the concern of Muhammadiyah.
